## Spring 2024 Barr Engage New England Student Survey - Nowell Leadership Academy Full Report

SRI Education researchers surveyed Nowell Leadership Academy (Nowell) students in spring 2024. At Nowell, 112 out of 172 students responded to the survey, for a school response rate of 65%. Across the Beyond ENE initiative, 403 out of 632 students responded to the survey, for an initiative response rate of 64%.

This report presents item-level responses of students from Nowell. As a comparison, we also present the distribution of school means (mean, standard deviation, minimum, and maximum) for the 5 Beyond ENE schools.
